**SUBJECT:**                      **SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT - ACTION**

**Request for Pre-Labor Day Opening of School**

**BACKGROUND:**                      **In 5 of the last 10 school years, Bath County Public Schools has been closed an average of 14.4 days per year**

**The division meets the “good cause” provision as defined by the Code of Virginia by being closed an average of 8 days per year during any 5 of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or other emergency situations.**

**RECOMMENDATION:**                      **The Board must certify that Bath County Public Schools meets an allowable provision for a pre-Labor Day opening of the 2018-2019 school year.**

**REGARDING:** Pre-Labor Day Opening

The local school board shall submit annually to the Superintendent of Public Instruction certification of eligibility for a waiver of the “good cause” requirements of §22.1-79.1, *Code of Virginia*. Such certification shall be made in a manner prescribed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

House Bill 557 and Senate Bill 253 were passed by the 2010 General Assembly and amended §22.1-79.1 of the *Code*. Effective July 1, 2010, the *Code* **permits school divisions to self-certify that they meet one of the “good cause” provisions of the Code to enable the school division to open prior to Labor Day**. Section 22.1-79.1 reads as follows:

For purposes of this section, “good cause” means:

“A school division has been closed an average of eight (8) days per year during any five of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or other emergency situations.”

As of April 19, 2018 Bath County Public Schools has been closed an average of **14.4 days per year** in five of the last 10 years.

Average days missed in five (5) years = 14.4

The attached page needs to be signed by the School Board chairman to verify that Bath County Public Schools meets the requirements to begin the 2018-2019 school year before Labor Day.
